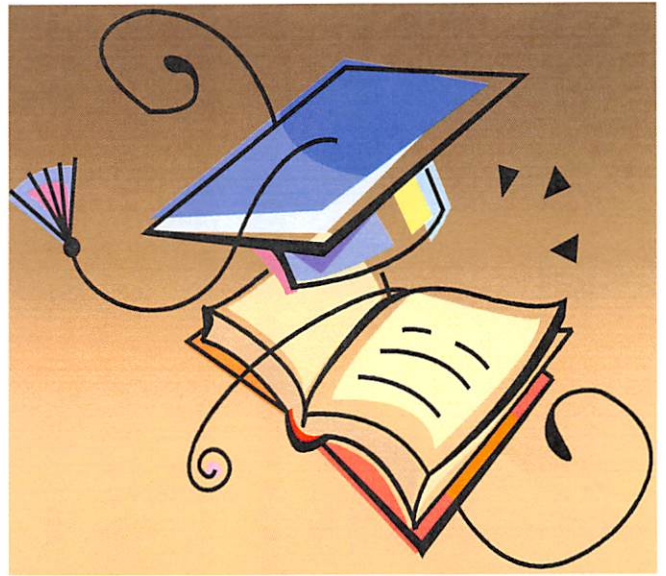


SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT for 2016 -2017 ACADEMIC YEAR

Purpose:

Our purpose is to recognize worthy, deserving and outstanding individuals who are interested in pursuing a profession in the field of Agriculture and Environmental Science, Forest Resources and/or Family and Consumer Sciences.

Awards:

*One scholarship of \$1500.00 will be awarded. The winner will receive \$750.00 for the first year of college and \$750.00 for the second year of college.
The winner should bring receipt of tuition payment to Whitfield County Farm Bureau office during the quarter/semester in which the payment was made.*

Eligibility:

The award will be made to a student who is pursuing (as a full time student) a Bachelor of Science degree in Agriculture and Environmental Science, Forest Resources or Family and Consumer Sciences.

Students submitting the hand written application must enroll in a unit of the University system of Georgia or Berry College during the 2016 – 2017 academic year, and pursue a course of study stated above.

Requirements:

The finalist will be required to have an interview with the Promotion and Education committee. Winners must also enter college within one year from the time of notification of winning the scholarship.

Award: A Scholarship will be awarded to the top student who confirms they are majoring in agriculture or a related field.

The student will each receive a scholarship of \$1500.00

The winner will be announced prior and awarded at the Schools Senior Awards Day.

Eligibility: The school scholarship application must be filled out and submitted to the Whitfield County Farm Bureau office.
Students submitting an application **must be a high school senior for the current academic year and plan to be enrolled in a unit of a University System, accredited college, or a technical school pursuing an undergraduate degree in agricultural and environmental sciences, family and consumer sciences or a related agricultural field.**

Application Requirements: Completed application signed by student.

Judging: A three member committee will judge the award. No one related to the applicant will serve on this committee. Judging will be based on post graduate plans, involvement in agriculture, community service involvement, leadership experience, and financial need.
